REIMBURSEMENT OF THE ACT OF TELECARDIOLOGY IN FRANCE



The act of remote monitoring of cardiac prostheses connected in France is now supported by social security up to 130 € per year/patient. The decree of November 14th concerning this assumption of responsibility was published in the official journal.

Remote monitoring represents major challenges in the healthcare industry: cost reduction for health insurance, 50% reduction in mortality to one year, time and productivity savings for rhythmologists and their teams. Despite the benefits of tele-monitoring, only 10% of eligible patients are already monitored by medical teams because of the technical and organizational difficulty involved.

The platform is the culmination of a long effort to optimize the remote monitoring data support, the first step in a development that integrates artificial intelligence and everyday tools for rhythmologists and patients.

« We were waiting for the publication of the decree, Implicity will fully benefit from this experiment. It was abnormal and unfair that 90% of patients were not televised for economic and organizational reasons. Now that a financial incentive exists, it remains for the centers to be able to deploy these solutions; Implicity is the only platform in Europe to offer a global patient monitoring tool, and to integrate all the devices of the 5 manufacturers. With already thirty hospitals in discussion, Implicity will be able to contribute to the improvement of care and the benefits will be for both patients and all medical teams » confirms Arnaud Rosier, Rhythmologist and CEO of the company.

The start-up, already acclaimed by many French centers and laureate of numerous prizes (2016 innovation prize of the French telemedicine company, 3rd place in the I-LAB contest, CIN) will accelerate its development thanks to the place of this refund.

Created in May 2016, Implicity offers an innovative platform for remote monitoring of connected cardiac prostheses (pacemakers, defibrillators). Created by cardiologists for cardiologists, this service allows remote management of alerts from connected devices from 5 global manufacturers (Medtronic, Abbott, Boston Scientific, Biotronik, Liva Nova) via a single harmonized platform.

A filtering of the received alerts makes it possible to guarantee a better support of the patients and a saving of time for the rhythmologists.

Implicity's goal is to simplify and optimize the remote monitoring of connected cardiac implants to improve the quality of care provided, in particular by the use of artificial intelligence methods that have required several years of development.
